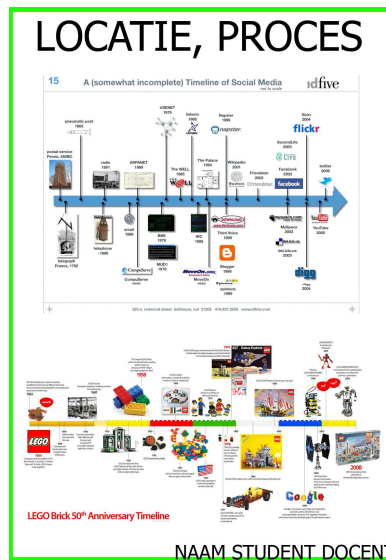

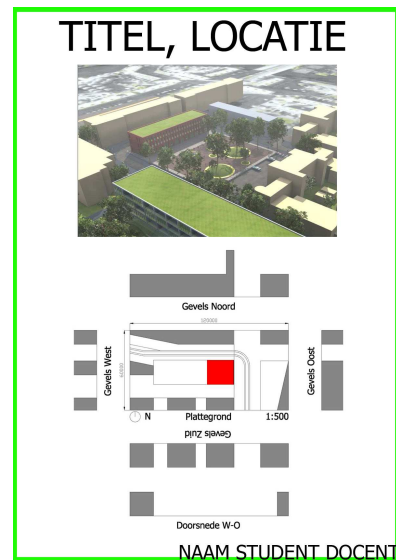

Panel 1: research and process



Panel 2: design

1. Research Panel: Research, process, participation en interaction

This panel is an illustrated timeline summing up your actions in relation to your research plan. Show the research as a continuous development. Write comments to what happened. What worked well? What was disappointing? What was a real finding? Use iconography to make yourself understood. Smiley's, icons, photographs, loose words, but not a lot of writing. This is the essence of your research using your research maps and images you made and reactions you gathered.

2. Design Panel

This panels shows one or two of your elaborated artist's impressions as an eye catcher and the drawings in the appropriate scale. Choose and mention the scale appropriate for your design, e.g. 1:20 or 1:50. Put an arrow to indicate North, the name of the buildings and the streets. Draw the target group of your research as realistic figures in such a way that the use of your object is clearly visible.

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3. Model(s)

Build your Final Design in a model of the appropriate scale. The model itself is abstract, the design visually jumps out. Put the name of the design onto the model. Mention the scale appropriate for your design, e.g. 1:1, 1:20 or 1:50. Put an arrow to indicate North, the name of the buildings and the streets. Be sure to make photographs of your model before the lesson.

4. USB stick with all files of your project

Bring all your files on a digital carrier to the lesson. A USB will be brought back to the counter of the Academy after 2 weeks, bring a DVD or CD alternatively.

On the device is a folder stating your name like this: **LEHNER_Mathias** with in it 4 folders: **pres** (pdf's of your panels, and some photographs of your model), **loos** (the loose files of your presentation in Indesign, jpg, dwg etc), the folder **proc** (all other files you even produce in this course) and the folder **mus** containing the design music you were listening to while doing this project.
